

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING LAKESIDE TENNIS**

**(1) Why should I fill out a contact card the first time I visit the Williams Tennis Center?**

The staff makes an effort to arrange games for Lakeside guests. If we have your contact information, we can call to invite you to play. In addition, we send out emails periodically about tennis activities at Lakeside.

**(2) What is the Lakeside Tennis Club and why should I join?**

The Lakeside Tennis Club is made up of tennis players who enjoy playing tennis at Lakeside and want to promote the program. Their annual dues (\$10 for individuals and \$25 for families) pay for equipment and activities not covered by the annual operating expenses provided by the Lakeside Association. Checks made out to Lakeside Tennis Club may be given to the tennis director at the Williams Tennis Center or sent to the Association (see 6 below).

**(3) Why do I have to register at the desk before taking a court? I never had to do this before.**

The demand for court time is increasing. When others are waiting for a court, play is limited to 60 minutes for singles and 90 minutes for doubles. Registration enables guests and staff to know how long players have been on a court so time limits can be enforced fairly. In addition, staff members need to verify that persons wishing to play on the soft courts have the appropriate kind of tennis shoes. And finally, the court assignment sheets maintained by the staff provide the

Lakeside Association with a record of how many guests use the tennis facilities.

**(4) Why is there a one dollar charge for the round robins?**

This fee covers the cost of new balls, which are provided daily for every round robin court. The used balls are then recycled for use during free children's lessons.

**(5) If I have suggestions about how to improve the tennis program at Lakeside, whom do I contact?**
