Welcome Packets

Directions to Lakeside Chautauqua are available at www.lakesideohio.com/directions. Please arrive through the **South Gate entrance** along Route 163. A welcome packet will be distributed at this gate **under your name, listed with the 'Plein Air Artist Group.'** The packet will include Daily Chautauqua Passes, which are valid for admission to the grounds for the entire weekend and grant access to all Hoover Auditorium programs. Review the flyer in your packet for a listing of events. Parking is available at the South Gate Parking Lot, based on availability. A golf cart shuttle transports guests to the downtown business district.

Art Sales

Artists are permitted to bring studio work of the surrounding Lakeside area. However, it must be original artwork, **no prints are allowed**. Artists are only permitted to sell artwork during the **Wet Paint Sale from 2:30-4 p.m. Sunday, July 16**. Transactions for the art sale must be conducted through Lakeside Chautauqua.

Painting Sites

A map of Lakeside will be provided to indicate possible painting sites. Gardens, parks, lakefront walkways, historic buildings and unique cottages are popular locations. Wherever you plan to set up, if there is any doubt whether you are on someone's property, please ask first and paint later. It only takes a few minutes, and it may make all the difference as to how future projects like this will be received. While you are painting, please display your yellow artist flag, which will be available for pick up at the South Gate entrance.

Please note: artists are required to paint from 12-1:30 p.m. Sunday, July 16 along the waterfront where the Lakeside Wooden Boat Show & Plein Air Art Festival will be taking place. Please paint near the Hotel Lakeside, Central Park, Dock or along the waterfront from the west gate to the gazebo.

Wet Paint Sale

The Wet Paint Sale will be held from 2:30-4 p.m. Sunday, July 16 near the Pavilion. No sales are allowed before **2:30 p.m.** Bring your easel and set up on the grass near the Pavilion. Artists may show their work either framed, matted or unframed. **Transactions for all art sales must be conducted through Lakeside, and Lakeside will take 20%.**

Each artist will receive a number in their welcome packet, which is your site location for the Wet Paint Sale. A stake will be placed in the ground with your number, which will be the right front corner of your area with the site number facing away from you. If you have questions, please ask at the payment tent.

The rain location for the Wet Paint Sale will be the Upper Pavilion/Pavilion East Deck. Please, look for an email if the weather is forecasted to be inclement.

During the weekend, artists are invited to visit Artists-N-Cahoots, a gallery/store that sells artwork from volunteer artists at Lakeside's Rhein Center. The store is located on Walnut Avenue near the Lakeside Chautauqua Administration Office. Joyce Christman and Erin Rosson can supply you with further information.
