Summary:

The Event Team Set-Up employee reports to the Manager of Conference and Events. This is a seasonal position within the Conference & Event Planning Department with varying day and evening hours based on the events' schedule. These individuals will work in a fast-paced environment as part of a team that set up and tear down for events throughout the campus.

Ideal candidates are physically active, good listeners and forward thinkers with high energy and a positive attitude. Ability to work as part of a team is a must.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work as a team to set up events, including banquets, parties, weddings, reunions, meetings, etc.
- Work as a team to tear down events and thoroughly clean venues
- Responsible for transporting equipment across the grounds in Lakeside vehicle
- Set up and troubleshoot audiovisual and sound equipment for events (training provided)
- Report to the Manager of Conference & Events on a daily basis
- Any and all other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Education and/or Experience:

High school diploma or its equivalent. Must have a valid Ohio Driver's License in order to drive a Lakeside vehicle. Also a working knowledge of audiovisual and sound equipment preferred, but not required.

Mathematical Skills:

Ability to apply basic math concepts.

Reasoning Ability:

Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram or schedule form.

Physical Demands and Work Environment:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit, stand, walk, use hand to finger, handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop or kneel, talk or hear, taste or smell.
